County Council Meeting

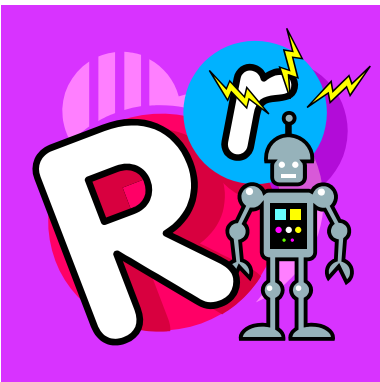
