

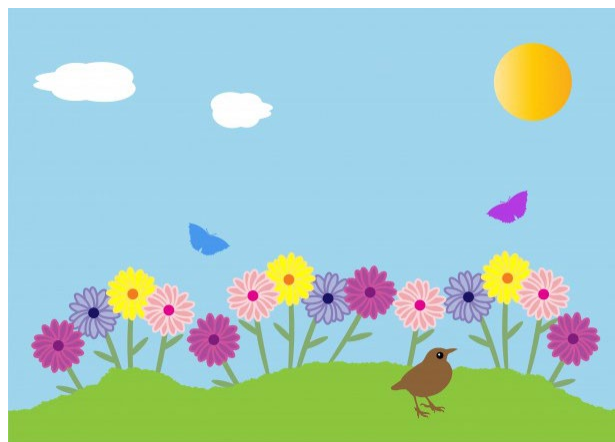

MG Training Class: The next Master Gardener training class will be held on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 - 9:00 p.m. October 1, 2019 through February 18, 2019 in Redlands.

Requirements: Graduates are required to volunteer a minimum of 50 hours by June 30, 2021 by educating the public on various gardening and landscape topics and promoting community activity.

Hybrid Course Option: High desert and mountain residents have the option of completing the course online supplemented with two 1/2 day Saturday training sessions in the local area.

Applications: Applications are due by August 31, 2019. Applicants must pay \$175 class fee (includes textbook and all class materials) and pass a background check. Apply [HERE](#).
